## **ELIGIBILITY & APPLICATION**

- 1. [NEW GEOGRAPHIES] Any student currently enrolled in any school (home school included) or college/university in: Calhoun, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lexington, Newberry, Orangeburg, Richland, or Saluda County is eligible to compete. Teachers are not required to be a member of either music club (Eau Claire Music Club or Afternoon Music Club).
- 2. Competition is limited to students in grade 6 through College Junior. AGE LIMIT IS 25!
- 3. Students may enter up to TWO Categories, but may not be chosen a winner in the same Category in the same Division for 2 consecutive years. An application and fee are required for each category.
- 4. An entering student must be in at least his/her second year of study.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained from the scholarship chair and must be postmarked by Jan. 23, 2021.

- 6. A registration fee of \$20.00 must accompany each application. Make check payable to the "Music Clubs Scholarship Fund."
- 7. HARD/xeroxed COPIES OF ORIGINAL or PURCHASED DOWNLOADED MUSIC should be mailed with Application & Fee to the Event Chair. Music will be discarded/NOT returned.
- 8. Failure to follow guidelines and AUDITION/PERFORMANCE TIME ALLOTMENTS will disqualify entrant.
- 9. ALL WINNERS are expected to perform on the Scholarship Winners Recital at Columbia College on Sunday, Feb. 21, 2021 (Tentative) at 3:00 pm. Winners must secure their own accompanist, if needed. 5 min. for Intermediate Solo; 8 mi. for Intermediate Concerto;
  - 10 minutes preferred/max 15 min for Solo & Concerto for Secondary/ Senior/ Collegiate. TIME LIMITS ARE MANDATORY.
- 10. Double Winners (in 2 different categories) will perform for the Recital only one selection not to exceed the time limit in #9

#### **CATEGORIES & DIVISIONS/PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS**

- 1. Piano Solo (4 Divisions): Intermediate (gr.6-8); Secondary (gr.9-11); Senior (gr.12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior) One scholarship of \$200 will be awarded in Intermediate; \$300 in Secondary; \$400 in Senior; \$500 in Collegiate.
- 2. Piano Concerto (3 Divisions): Intermediate (gr.6-8); Secondary (gr.9-11); Senior (gr.12) One scholarship of: \$200 - Intermediate; \$300 - Secondary; \$400 - Senior.

NOTE: Up to FIVE Rice Music House Scholarships of \$150 each will be awarded in any Division of Piano.

- 3. Voice (2 Divisions): Senior (gr. 12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior) One scholarship of: \$400 - Senior; \$500 - Collegiate
- 4. Strings/ (4 Divisions): Intermediate (gr. 6-8); Secondary (gr. 9-11); Senior (gr. 12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior) **Classical Guitar** One scholarship of: \$200 - Intermediate; \$300 - Secondary; \$400 - Senior; \$500 - Collegiate
- 5. Brass/Woodwinds/ (4 Divisions): Intermediate (gr. 6-8); Secondary (gr. 9-11); Senior (gr. 12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior)
- Percussion One scholarship of: \$200 - Intermediate; \$300 - Secondary; \$400 - Senior; \$500 - Collegiate
- 6. Organ Organists may contact Brenda Dean. Location of auditions: TBA

### **PREPARATION OF STUDENTS**

- 1. Music chosen for audition shall be selected from acceptable recital and teaching literature. Entrants must have at least 2 contrasting pieces. Only 1 piece is required for Piano Concerto.
- 2. Maximum playing time in the audition for Intermediate Divisions, (Solo and Piano Concerto), is 8 minutes. Secondary, Senior & Collegiate Divisions, (Solo and Piano Concerto), preferably 10 min. or less/max of 15 minutes.
- 3. Memorization is required in all piano and voice divisions. Other divisions may use music scores.
- 4. Instrumental/Vocal candidates must provide an accompanist. Teachers may accompany concerti.

### "YouTube" STUDENT PERFORMANCE of audition pieces – Email LINK to Mrs. Dean by Jan. 23, 2021.

- 1. Subject title of email: STUDENT 1st NAME, LAST INITIAL; GRADE; CATEGORY
- 2. Within the body of the email include: Link; All the Above Subject Title; plus, specific INSTRUMENT. [This is the AUDITION!]
- 3. Pianists: Record full sideview showing hands, feet, top of piano. Vocalists: Front view. Others: Sideview, if using music

### **JUDGES**

- 1. Usually: 1 judge Strings; 1 judge -Brass/WW/Percussion; 2-3 judges Piano, 1 judge Voice, 1 Organ, if applicable.
- 2. Judges will write critiques of the performance, addressing musical skills, appropriate interpretation, style, etc....
- 3. Completed Critiques will be postal mailed to teachers.
- 4. Awards will be given at the discretion of the judge and available funding.
- 5. If the LIVE WINNERS RECITAL is not allowed, awards will be postal mailed to winners with certificates and a copy of the program.
